

STATEMENT OF NOTIFICATION OF MEDICATIONS POLICY AGREEMENT

The Run For A Million Competition, \$100,000 Added Open Shoot Out and 2024 Million Dollar Competition Qualifier - August 18, 2023 THE RUN FOR A MILLION MEDICATION POLICY ADDITION: All forms of tranquilizing agents <u>including Romifidine, or any</u> <u>generic/compounded version thereof</u>, are considered illegal substances. Any horse, found with illegal substances or legal medications outside the defined limits, will be disqualified from qualifying for the 2024 Million Dollar Competition. This exclusion of the use of Romifidine is outside the rules of the National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) medications policies. However, it has been approved for this event by the NRHA.

The top five horse's in this competition, in addition to all horses marking a 226.5 or higher, will have a blood sample drawn, and urine when possible, by a licensed veterinarian for testing for illegal substances, or legal substances outside approved limited as defined in the rules of the National Reining Horse Association Handbook. Tests will be submitted by a licensed veterinarian to the NRHA designated independent lab testing facility. Horses who test positive for illegal substances, or legal substances outside the approved limits will be disqualified from competition, resulting in forfeiture of all cash and prize winnings. Disqualified horses/exhibitors will not receive any reimbursements for competition expenses including but not limited to entries, stalls, feed, bedding, hotels and transportation.

BEHAVIOR, CONDUCT AND ANIMAL WELFARE: Any unprofessionalism, conduct unbecoming an exhibitor or entrant, (whether an owner, participant, family of a participant, or other such agent as that term shall be defined by BRUMLEY MANAGEMENT GROUP (BMG), disrespect, deceit, disparagement, directed to the event, show management, grounds crew, show representatives, co-participants or team members, sponsors, judges and/or the network will result in disqualification from competition and removal from the facility. No reimbursements for competition expenses including but not limited to entries, stalls, feed, bedding, hotels and transportation will be provided and said individual will be subject to the disciplinary procedures set forth by the National Reining Horse Association in Article A of the handbook. Anyone found to be abusing animals will be immediately disqualified from the event, removed from the facility, and reported to NRHA. IN ADDITION, THESE INDIVIDUALS WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY BRUMLEY MANAGEMENT GROUP EVENTS INCLUDING TRFAM FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE YEAR. Reinstatement of the right to exhibit is based on review by BMG show management.
